


Figure 1: Solve this hard chess puzzle 0066. Mate in 3 moves @ <https://gbud.in/gkwfcp3>

Solution to hard chess puzzle 0066

At this puzzle, next **move** is by **White**. The objective of the puzzle is to mate in 3 moves.

Solution 1

Initial board position This is the initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0066.




Figure 3: Initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0066

Move 1 Move by black




Figure 4: Bg4 - Your opponent is trying to pin your knight to your queen. If you move your knight, their bishop will capture queen

Move 2 Move by white




Figure 5: Nxe5 - You are ready to sacrifice your queen for a possible check-mate. With this movement, you opened the diagonal for the opponent's bishop to attack your queen. At the same time, your knight will now attack f7 which is supported by their king alone

Move 3 Move by black




Figure 6: Bxd1 - Your opponent captures your queen as it is of more value than a bishop. For them it is a material gain. However, they have not realised the threat made by your knight

Move 4 Move by white




Figure 7: Bf7+ - Bishop captures the pawn at f7 and gives a check. Opponent's king can not capture your bishop since it is supported by your knight

Move 5 Move by black




Figure 8: Ke7 - Opponent's king responds to the check threat as this is only free square available

Move 6 Move by white




Figure 9: Nd5# - Your another knight moves and gives a checkmate. The king has no free squares to move. This is how you can mate in 3 moves

Right moves for the solution to the hard chess puzzle 0066

Based on the objective of the puzzle, you have to make the right moves. Following are the right moves

1. Nxe5, Bf7+, Nd5#

Explanation for the moves

1. Bg4 - Your opponent is trying to pin your knight to your queen. If you move your knight, their bishop will capture queen
2. Nxe5 - You are ready to sacrifice your queen for a possible checkmate. With this movement, you opened the diagonal for the opponent's bishop to attack your queen. At the same time, your knight will now attack f7 which is supported by their king alone
3. Bxd1 - Your opponent captures your queen as it is of more value than a bishop. For them it is a material gain. However, they have not realised the threat made by your knight
4. Bf7+ - Bishop captures the pawn at f7 and gives a check. Opponent's king can not capture your bishop since it is supported by your knight
5. Ke7 - Opponent's king responds to the check threat as this is only free square available
6. Nd5# - Your another knight moves and gives a checkmate. The king has no free squares to move. This is how you can mate in 3 moves
7. For right move - You have sacrificed your queen to mate in 3 moves. It was a right sacrifice
8. For wrong move - You could have sacrificed your queen to mate in 3 moves. Do not stop trying




Figure 14: Play chess online for free. Solve puzzles and play with friends
