


Figure 1: Solve this hard chess puzzle 0070. Mate in 3 moves @ <https://gbud.in/g1qz143>

Solution to hard chess puzzle 0070

At this puzzle, next **move** is by **White**. The objective of the puzzle is to mate in 3 moves.

Solution 1

Initial board position This is the initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0070.




Figure 3: Initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0070

Move 1 Move by white




Figure 4: Bc4+ - You can have a future checkmate, if you push the opponent's king to h8. Your bishop is doing this job by giving a check

Move 2 Move by black




Figure 5: Kh8 - Opponents king moves to h8

Move 3 Move by white




Figure 6: Qe5+ - Your queen moves to e5 and gives a check after king moved to h8

Move 4 Move by black




Figure 7: Qf6 - Opponents queen blocks the attack from your queen

Move 5 Move by white




Figure 8: Qxf6# - Your queen captures opponent's queen and checkmate. Opponent's king has no free squares to move. He can not come to g7 due to the attack from your pawn. This is how you can mate in 3 moves

Initial board position This is the initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0070.




Figure 9: Initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0070

Move 1 Move by white




Figure 10: Bc4+ - You can have a future checkmate, if you push the opponent's king to h8. Your bishop is doing this job by giving a check

Move 2 Move by black




Figure 11: Qf7 - Opponents queen blocks the attack from your bishop

Move 3 Move by white




Figure 12: Qxf7+ - Your queen captures opponent's queen and gives the next check. Now the king has to move to h8 as he can not capture your queen

Move 4 Move by black




Figure 13: Kh8 - Opponents king moves to h8

Move 5 Move by white




Figure 14: Qg7# - Your queen gives a checkmate. Opponent's king can not capture your queen since it is supported by the pawn. This is how you can mate in 3 moves




Figure 15: Initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0070

Move 1 Move by white




Figure 16: Bc4+ - You can have a future checkmate, if you push the opponent's king to h8. Your bishop is doing this job by giving a check

Move 2 Move by black




Figure 17: Kh8 - Opponents king moves to h8

Move 3 Move by white




Figure 18: Qe5+ - Your queen moves to e5 and gives a check after king moved to h8

Move 4 Move by black




Figure 19: Qg7+ - Opponents queen blocks the check threat from your queen and giving a check to your king at the same time.

Move 5 Move by white




Figure 20: $Qxg7\#$ - Your queen captures the opponent's queen and gives a checkmate. Opponent's king can not capture your queen since it is supported by the pawn. This is how you can mate in 3 moves

Right moves for the solution to the hard chess puzzle 0070

Based on the objective of the puzzle, you have to make the right moves. Following are the right moves

1. $Bc4+$, $Qe5+$, $Qxf6\#$
2. $Bc4+$, $Qxf7+$, $Qg7\#$
3. $Bc4+$, $Qe5+$, $Qxg7\#$

Explanation for the moves

1. $Bc4+$ - You can have a future checkmate, if you push the opponent's king to h8. Your bishop is doing this job by giving a check
2. $Qe5+$ - Your queen moves to e5 and gives a check after king moved to h8
3. $Qxf6\#$ - Your queen captures opponent's queen and checkmate. Opponent's king has no free squares to move. He can not come to g7 due to the attack from your pawn. This is how you can mate in 3 moves
4. $Qxf7+$ - Your queen captures opponent's queen and gives the next check. Now the king has to move to h8 as he can not capture your queen

5. Qg7# - Your queen gives a checkmate. Opponent's king can not capture your queen since it is supported by the pawn. This is how you can mate in 3 moves
6. Qxg7# - Your queen captures the opponent's queen and gives a checkmate. Opponent's king can not capture your queen since it is supported by the pawn. This is how you can mate in 3 moves
7. Qf7 - Opponents queen blocks the attack from your bishop
8. Qf6 - Opponents queen blocks the attack from your queen
9. Kh8 - Opponents king moves to h8
10. Qg7+ - Opponents queen blocks the check threat from your queen and giving a check to your king at the same time.
11. For right move - You have used your bishop effectively to have a mate in 3 moves. Good job
12. For wrong move - You could have pushed the opponent's king to h8 to have a checkmate in 3 moves. Try again




Figure 25: Play chess online for free. Solve puzzles and play with friends
