


Figure 1: Solve this hard chess puzzle 0050. Mate in 4 moves @ https://gbud.in/gtzjjf3

Solution to hard chess puzzle 0050

At this puzzle, next move is by Black. The objective of the puzzle is to mate in 4 moves.

Solution 1

Initial board position This is the initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0050.




Figure 3: Initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0050

 ${\bf Move \ 1} \quad {\rm Move \ by \ white}$




Figure 4: Kb1 - King moves to b1

Move 2 Move by black




Figure 5: a4 - Pawn moves forward since promotion of the pawn will help you win the game for sure in four moves.

Move 3 Move by white




Figure 6: Kc1 - Since a1 is attacked by the bishop, the king moves back to c1

Move 4 Move by black




Figure 7: a3 - Checkmate is certain since the king is locked in first rank by the rook which is supported by the bishop

Move 5 Move by white




Figure 8: Kd1 - Since king can not move to second rank, it wanders in first rank

Move 6 Move by black




Figure 9: a 2 - The promoted piece will also be supported by the bishop

 ${\bf Move \ 7} \quad {\rm Move \ by \ white}$




Figure 10: Ke1 - The king has only two choices. Either move to c1 or e1

Move 8 Move by black




Figure 11: a1=Q# - The pawn is promoted to a queen and checkmate. This is called ladder mate.

Solution 2

Initial board position This is the initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0050.




Figure 12: Initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0050




Figure 14: a4 - Pawn moves forward since promotion of the pawn will help you win the game for sure in four moves.

Move 3 Move by white




Figure 15: Kc1 - Since a1 is attacked by the bishop, the king moves back to c1

 ${\bf Move \ 4} \quad {\rm Move \ by \ black}$




Figure 16: a3 - Checkmate is certain since the king is locked in first rank by the rook which is supported by the bishop

Move 5 Move by white




Figure 17: Kd1 - Since king can not move to second rank, it wanders in first rank

Move 6 Move by black




Figure 18: a2 - The promoted piece will also be supported by the bishop

 ${\bf Move \ 7} \quad {\rm Move \ by \ white}$




Figure 19: Ke1 - The king has only two choices. Either move to c1 or e1

Move 8 Move by black




Figure 20: a1=R# - The pawn is promoted to a rook and checkmate. This is called ladder mate.

Right moves for the solution to the hard chess puzzle 0050

Based on the objective of the puzzle, you have to make the right moves. Following are the right moves

- 1. a4, a3, a2, a1=Q#
- 2. a4, a3, a2, a1=R#

Explanation for the moves

- 1. a4 Pawn moves forward since promotion of the pawn will help you win the game for sure in four moves.
- 2. a3 Checkmate is certain since the king is locked in first rank by the rook which is supported by the bishop
- 3. a2 The promoted piece will also be supported by the bishop
- 4. a1=Q# The pawn is promoted to a queen and checkmate. This is called ladder mate.
- 5. a1=R# The pawn is promoted to a rook and checkmate. This is called ladder mate.
- 6. Kb1 King moves to b1
- 7. Kc1 Since a1 is attacked by the bishop, the king moves back to c1
- 8. Kd1 Since king can not move to second rank, it wanders in first rank
- 9. Ke1 The king has only two choices. Either move to c1 or e1

- 10. For right move You know that promotion of a pawn will give you a checkmate in 4 moves. You have a good understanding of the game
- 11. For wrong move You could have promoted your pawn to a queen or a rook. This would have fetched you a win. Try again




Figure 21: Click the solution button to view solutions @ https://gbud.in/gtzjjf3




Figure 22: Click the help button to get help on next move @ https://gbud. in/gtzjjf3
