


Figure 1: Solve this hard chess puzzle 0057. Mate in 2 moves @ https://gbud.in/gnt8lf3

Solution to hard chess puzzle 0057

At this puzzle, next move is by White. The objective of the puzzle is to mate in 2 moves.

Solution 1

Initial board position This is the initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0057.




Figure 3: Initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0057

Move 1 Move by white




Figure 4: Rh8+ - This will force the king to move from eighth rank.

Move 2 Move by black




Figure 5: Ke7 - King moves to e7

Move 3 Move by white




Figure 6: Bg7# - This attack is from a discovered check as the movement of the bishop results in the check from the rook. Your bishop also stops the opponent's king from moving to f6. This is how you can mate in 2 moves

Initial board position This is the initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0057.




Figure 7: Initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0057

Move 1 Move by white




Figure 8: Rhf1 - As c8, c7 and d7 are already attacked by your bishop and knight, opponent's king will next move to e file. This move is to attack the f file.

Move 2 Move by black




Figure 9: Ke7 - King moves to e7

Move 3 Move by white




Figure 10: Bc7# - This is a discovered check as the movement of the bishop uncovers the attack from the rook. This bishop also attacks d8 so that the opponent's king wont move there. This is how you can mate in 2 moves

Solution 3

Initial board position This is the initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0057.




Figure 11: Initial board position of hard chess puzzle 0057

Move 1 Move by white




Figure 12: Rhf1 - As c8, c7 and d7 are already attacked by your bishop and knight, opponent's king will next move to e file. This move is to attack the f file.

Move 2 Move by black




Figure 13: Ke8 - King moves to e8

Move 3 Move by white




Figure 14: Bc7# - This is a discovered check as the movement of the bishop uncovers the attack from the rook. This bishop also attacks d8 so that the opponent's king wont move there. This is how you can mate in 2 moves

Right moves for the solution to the hard chess puzzle 0057

Based on the objective of the puzzle, you have to make the right moves. Following are the right moves

- 1. Rh8+, Bg7#
- 2. Rhf1, Bc7#

Explanation for the moves

- 1. Rh8+ This will force the king to move from eighth rank.
- 2. Bg7# This attack is from a discovered check as the movement of the bishop results in the check from the rook. Your bishop also stops the opponent's king from moving to f6. This is how you can mate in 2 moves
- 3. Rhf1 As c8, c7 and d7 are already attacked by your bishop and knight, opponent's king will next move to e file. This move is to attack the f file.
- 4. Bc7# This is a discovered check as the movement of the bishop uncovers the attack from the rook. This bishop also attacks d8 so that the opponent's king wont move there. This is how you can mate in 2 moves

- 5. Ke7 King moves to e7
- 6. Ke8 King moves to e8
- 7. For right move You are cautious not to end the game in a draw as there are chances to stalemate. You avoided them. Good decision
- 8. For wrong move You should have used one of your rooks and a discovered attack to mate in 2 moves. Try again

- 2. Click the help button (exclamation mark as shown below) to get help or suggestion on next possible move




Figure 16: Click the help button to get help on next move @ https://gbud. in/gnt8lf3
